Commissioner of Insurance	Natasha Marcus	"I will force insurance companies to justify their rate increases with evidence [] and if they cannot, I will refuse to rate rates."
NC Auditor	Jessica Holmes	As Auditor, she already identified hundreds of thousands of dollars in missing funds. Opponent is a proud Trumper.
Commissioner of Agriculture	Sarah Taber	PhD in crop science and wants to prioritize crops that can bring in more revenue and production.
